IL SC STAKEHOLDER GROUP - SURVEY/NEEDS ASSESSMENT

This Group includes service coordinators and program managers from across that state as well as EITP staff and IDHS representatives working to empower, prepare and support service coordinators in Illinois. This group will distribute a survey in the spring to ALL service coordinators and those who support them within the IL SC Model (e.g. Program Managers, Parent Liaisons, Social Emotional Consultants (SECs), Local Interagency Council (LIC) Coordinators, and Pediatric Technical Assistant (TA) providers). The survey will help us understand:

- 1. The various ways that individuals at the CFC are motivated and able to grow as professionals (including the things service coordinators may seek for recognition, satisfaction and leadership development);
- 2. The knowledge and skills service coordinators need to have to be effective and efficient in their role; and
- 3. Needs identified by service coordinators as it relates to their existing knowledge and skills.
